


'...Allah has obligated them to pay charity from their wealth (i.e. Zakat), to be taken from the rich among them and then distributed to their poor...' Prophet (s)



Zakat is the third of the five basic pillars of Islam, Zakat is primarily an act of worship. The Arabic word 'Zakah' literally means purification, growth, blessing and appreciation.

Zakat is a compulsory religious duty conferred by Allah (swt) upon all adult Muslims whose wealth exceeds the prescribed limit. If a person's wealth exceeds that limit, they are required to pay the rate of 2.5% of total income or wealth annually for the upkeep of the poor and the needy.

#### Why give it?

Those who are fortunate enough, are required to look after their less fortunate brothers and sisters. By paying Zakat, we acknowledge that our wealth is in fact not our own but a blessing to be shared and an important act that cleanses our hearts against selfishness and greed.

#### Who benefits?

At Ehsaas, your Zakat is used in many of our life-changing projects and helps: The Poor, The Needy, Those in Debt, Those in the Cause of Allah, The Wayfairer, Those in Captivity, Those Whose Hearts have to be Reconciled & the Administrators of Zakat

## Ramadan Reminders

#### Fidvah: \$240

Payable for a person who has become extremely weak due to old age or disease, has no hope of recovery and cannot fast. They must feed a deserving person twice a day or give the value of the meals. Your doctor will be able to advise you on the nature of your illness.

#### Kaffarah: \$480


Payable for a person who has broken a fast in Ramadan without a valid reason and they are unable to fast for 2 months continuously with no break in between. They must feed 60 deserving people two meals a day for 1 month or give the total value of the meals. All missed/broken fasts still need to be made up.

#### Zakat-ul-Fitr: \$8

Obligatory for every person to pay before Eid prayer. Remember to pay on behalf of any children or elderly members of your household. The amount of fitrah is the value of one meal for a needy person. Please forward amount by 10th Ramadan so Ehsaas field offices can use your Zakat-ul-Fitr funds on the day of Eid.



Whoever feeds a fasting person will have a reward like that of the fasting person, without any reduction in his reward.' Prophet (s)






# REAL LIFE STORY

#### **Sehrish**

Sehrish, a 24-year-old MSc Finance student from Lahore needed a desperate liver transplant and treatment for her illness and her family approached Ehsaas for help. Your donations during the 'Naiki' Segment raised over \$37,850 to provide her with treatment.
